How Does It Work?

After you sell soil testing to your customer, mail the soil sample to one of Waypoint's seven test facilities across the country. When the results are ready, Waypoint will push the results directly to Service Assistant 5.

What Will You Get?



A linked document with a URL link to the soil sample in the Waypoint portal



A call log entry tied to the customer, including a note about the sample



The customer's record will be updated with the pH from the sample

Start by establishing an account with Waypoint Analytical. Waypoint will then reach out to Real Green Systems' API support group to set up your integration.
